Chords in parenthesis are called **PASSING CHORDS**. The job of these chords is to signal the end of a phrase. In this song, the passing chords are only played at the **END** of each verse & chorus. Try inserting the passing chords at the end of each verse & chorus (for more advanced students) or without the passing chords (for beginner students).
