



Lesson Plan 9: Recording Vocals



Objective

Record vocals or another audio track to your project

Procedures

1. Add a new track to your project and select “Vocals & microphones”.
2. If you have them, plug your headphones into your computer, phone, or tablet.
3. Sing into your device so Soundtrap and automatically set your microphone level.
4. Record your voice.
5. If you mess up or want to try again, delete your track and rerecord.



Voice & microphones

Resources - Lyric Writing Prompts

1. Pick an object and describe it with all five sense (sight, touch, smell, taste, hearing). Pick the most interesting ones to use in your lyrics.
2. Take a common phrase and flip it (“Warm shoulder” instead of “Cold shoulder”). What might that new phrase mean?
3. Write a song from the perspective of a character you like from a book, movie, or TV show.
4. Write a response song to a song you disagree with.

Questions

1. How did it feel hearing the sound of your voice on the recording?
2. How did you determine what to sing?
3. What do you want to do next to add to your song?
