



Technology Tools: Clean a Song with Soundtrap

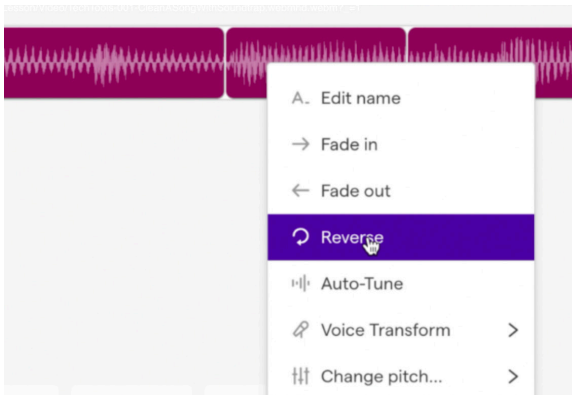


Objective

Edit out or mask unwanted lyrical content from a song

Resources

1. Open a new project in [Soundtrap.com](https://www.soundtrap.com)
2. Drag the audio file into the workspace. A new track will automatically be created
3. Find the moment in the audio that you want to edit.
4. Split the track at the beginning of that point by highlighting the track, dragging the playhead to the place you want the cut, and hitting Command + E
5. Repeat that process at the end of the word
6. Float over the new audio clip of the unwanted word and select Reverse.
7. Repeat for each word you want to remove. Save and download the song when you're done.



8. Alternately, add a karaoke version of the song to the project and sync the two up.
9. Split the karaoke and original versions at the same point.
10. Delete the unwanted word and replace it with the clip from the karaoke version.
11. Adjust the volumes to match
